- Sustain Abilities (Level 1): a partnered learning cohort series focused on fundraising and fund development to advance organizational sustainability. (WBF Initiative)
- Custom consulting support for organizational competencies of nonprofit excellence as a part of Foundation grant cycles.

Community Leadership

Equipping nonprofit leaders to become advocates for sector change and catalysts for community impact.

- Board Academy to advance community engagement and inclusion. (WBF Initiative)
- Sustain Abilities (series Level 4): highest level of the partnered learning cohort series focused on embedding succession and strategic planning at all levels for organizational sustainability. (WBF Initiative)
- Custom consulting support for collaboration, community leadership and advocacy as a part of Foundation grant cycles
